**In the evening, attend a welcome orientation meeting with your Tour Manager.**

**Robben Island ferry operations are weather dependent; alternate sightseeing will be arranged if necessary.**

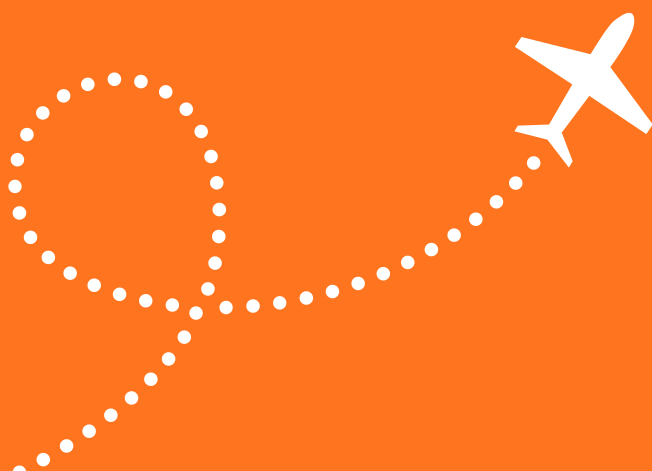

### **Sunday Day 4: Traditional African Dinner Experience**

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

- 300 days or more, prior to scheduled group arrival date, no PENALTY will be assessed
- 300-240 days prior to/up to group arrival date of trip: There will be a 25% Penalty of Total cost of room
- 240-180 day prior to/up to group arrival date: There will be a 50% Penalty of Total cost of room
- 180-150 days prior to/up to group arrival date: There will be a 75% Penalty of Total cost of room
